1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §153-A, sub-§3, ¶C,</b> as amended by PL 2007, c. 312, §2, is repealed.
4	SUMMARY
5	Under current law, an advocate or advocate attorney employed by the Workers'
6	Compensation Board may not represent before the board any insurer, self-insurer or 3rd-
7	party administrator for 2 years after terminating employment with the board. This bill
8	repeals that prohibition.
