1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §356 is enacted to read:
3	§356. Flexible hours for certain agency liquor stores
4	If an agency liquor store is subject to a substantial seasonal variation in business or
5	retail customers based upon tourism or other factors, the agency liquor store may have
6	flexibility in setting seasonal hours.
