### An Act Regarding the Board of Occupational Safety and Health

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §565, as amended by PL 1989, c. 712, is further amended to read:

#### §565. Powers and duties of board

The board shall formulate and adopt reasonable rules, pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter H  $\underline{2}$ , for safe and healthful working conditions, including rules requiring the use of personal protective equipment, monitoring and record keeping. The rules so formulated shall <u>must</u> at a minimum conform to federal standards of occupational safety and health; so that the state program can be federally approved as a public employee only occupational safety and health program. These rules shall not become effective sooner than 90 days after the date of adoption and promulgation.
