1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§9 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	9. Allocation to hunters 70 years of age and older. At least 10% of antlerless deer permits issued in a wildlife management district must be issued to eligible hunters 70 years of age and older.
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill requires that at least 10% of antlerless deer permits issued in a wildlife management district be issued to eligible hunters who are 70 years of age and older.
