1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1560-B, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 288, §1, is repealed.
4 5	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1560-B, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 288, §1, is amended to read:
6 7 8	2. Prohibition. Beginning January 1, 2016 2020, a person may not sell, furnish, give away or offer to sell, furnish or give away a nicotine liquid container unless the container is child-resistant packaging.
9 10	Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §1560-B, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 288, §1, is repealed.
11	Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020.
12	SUMMARY
13 14	This bill prohibits, beginning January 1, 2020, a person from selling, furnishing or giving away a nicotine liquid container.
