SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 306,  
L.D. 954, “An Act To Provide Equal Access to the Benefits of the Maine Food Sovereignty  
Act”

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §284 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd  
line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Second," the  
following: 'pursuant to the authority granted to plantations by Title 30-A, section 7051.'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §284 in the first indented paragraph in the 4th  
line (page 1, line 18 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "municipality" the  
following: 'or plantation'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies the authority of plantations to adopt ordinances regarding  
direct producer-to-consumer transactions for food or food products.
