17 18 19	(2) If the business does not meet the requirements of subparagraph (1), an officer, if the business is a corporation, a partner in the business or the sole proprietor must meet the requirements of paragraph A; or
20 21 22 23	(3) If the business does not meet the requirements of subparagraph (1) or (2), at least 60% of the individuals employed by the business are residents of this State. For purposes of this subparagraph, an individual is a resident of this State if the individual meets the requirements of Title 21-A, section 112.'

25 26 27	This amendment adds a 3rd way a business can qualify to be an in-state contractor for purposes of the Maine Buy America and Build Maine Act by including a business in which at least 60% of the employees are Maine residents.
