3 §1771. Inspection of new motor vehicles for rent

<u>Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1751, subsection 1, the initial inspection of</u>
<u>a new motor vehicle for rent is valid for 2 years or until the motor vehicle accrues 36,000</u>
<u>miles, whichever occurs earlier.</u> For purposes of this section, "new motor vehicle" has
the same meaning as in Title 10, section 1171, subsection 13.

- 9 This bill allows the initial inspection of new rental motor vehicles to last 2 years or 10 36,000 miles, whichever occurs earlier.
