2 3	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1125, sub-§8-C, ¶D, as enacted by IB 2015, c. 1, §25, is amended by amending subparagraph (3) to read:
4 5	(3) The total amount of revenues distributed for a contested general election may not exceed $\frac{60,000}{32,000}$ per candidate.
6 7	Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §1125, sub-§8-D, ¶D, as enacted by IB 2015, c. 1, §25, is amended by amending subparagraph (3) to read:
8 9	(3) The total amount of revenues distributed for a contested general election may not exceed $\frac{15,000}{88,200}$ per candidate.

11 12 13 14	This bill changes the total amount of revenues that may be distributed to Maine Clean Election Act candidates for contested general elections from \$60,000 to \$32,000 for State Senate candidates and from \$15,000 to \$8,200 for State House of Representative candidates.
