Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and Whereas, this legislation provides funds in fiscal year 2011-12 to cover the costs 3 4 associated with an independent feasibility study of an east-west highway; and 5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 6 7 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 8 therefore, 9 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 10 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made. 11 TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF 12 13 **Highway and Bridge Capital 0406** 14 Initiative: Provides a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$300,000 in fiscal year 2011-12 to the Department of Transportation to cover the costs associated with an 15 independent feasibility study of an east-west highway. 16 17 18 **GENERAL FUND** 2011-12 2012-13 19 All Other \$300,000 \$0 20 \$0 21 GENERAL FUND TOTAL \$300,000 22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this 23 legislation takes effect when approved. **SUMMARY** 24 25 This bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$300,000 in fiscal year 26 2011-12 to the Department of Transportation to cover the costs associated with an 27 independent feasibility study of an east-west highway.
