An Act To Increase the Membership of the Homeland Security Advisory Council

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §708, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 634, §12, is amended to read:

1. Membership. The council is composed of the following 69 members:

- A. The director;
- B. The Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management;
- C. The Commissioner of Public Safety;

D. The Director of the Bureau of Health <u>Maine Center for Disease Control and</u> <u>Prevention</u> within the Department of Health and Human Services;

- E. The Chief of the State Police within the Department of Public Safety; and
- F. A representative of the Governor-;

G. The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife or the commissioner's designee;

H. The Commissioner of Marine Resources or the commissioner's designee; and

I. The Commissioner of Conservation or the commissioner's designee.

The director is the chair of the council. The Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management is the advisor of the council. <u>Commissioner designees must be uniformed law enforcement personnel.</u>
