An Act To Promote Workforce Education Attainment

- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §2006, sub-§1, ¶¶I and J, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 114,
 §10, are amended to read:
- 4 I. Providing policy recommendations to ensure the effectiveness of work-related 5 programs and services for youth, including youth with disabilities; and
- J. Providing policy recommendations to ensure the effectiveness of work-related
 programs and services for "at-risk" youth-: and
- 8 Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §2006, sub-§1, ¶K is enacted to read:
- 9K. Supporting and tracking progress toward an attainment goal of increasing the10percent of working-age adults holding a high-value certificate, college degree,11vocational education or other industry-recognized credential to 60% by 2025 with a12focus on meeting future workforce needs and reporting annually on progress to the13joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and14cultural affairs and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction15over labor, business, research and economic development matters.

SUMMARY

17 This bill adds supporting an attainment goal of increasing the percent of working-age 18 adults holding a high-value certificate, college degree, vocational education or other industry-recognized credential to 60% by 2025 with a focus on meeting future workforce 19 needs to the list of responsibilities of the State Workforce Investment Board. The board 20 may seek information from the Maine Workforce and Education Coalition in regards to 21 an attainment goal. It also directs the Workforce Investment Board to track the State's 22 23 progress toward the attainment goal and to annually report on the progress to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural 24 25 affairs and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over labor, 26 business, research and economic development matters.
