4 5 6 7	1. Prohibition. A person may not perform or cause to be performed any activity listed in subsection 2, except as provided in subsection 5, without first obtaining a permit from the department if the activity is located in, on or over any protected natural resource or is located adjacent to any of the following:
8 9	A. A coastal wetland, great pond, river, stream or brook or significant wildlife habitat contained within a freshwater wetland; or
10	B. Freshwater wetlands consisting of or containing:
11 12 13	(1) Under normal circumstances, at least 20,000 square feet of aquatic vegetation, emergent marsh vegetation or open water, except for artificial ponds or impoundments; or
14	(2) Peatlands dominated by shrubs, sedges and sphagnum moss.
15 16	A person may not perform or cause to be performed any activity in violation of the terms or conditions of a permit.

19 20	2. Activities requiring a permit. The Except as provided in subsection 5, the following activities require a permit:

25	D. Any construction, repair or alteration of any permanent structure.

If erosion of a sand dune is caused by the construction, erection, improvement or maintenance of a structure by the Federal Government or of a structure owned by the Federal Government, a municipality may fill or add sand or other material to the sand dune or construct a structure on the sand dune for the purpose of stabilizing the sand dune.

33 34 35 36	This bill allows a municipality to fill or add sand or other material to a sand dune or construct a structure on a sand dune if the sand dune incurs erosion attributable to the construction, erection, improvement or maintenance of a structure by the Federal Government or of a structure owned by the Federal Government.
