**An Act To Allow Certain Bulk Sale Customers To Opt Out of Paper Delivery Tickets**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §2624, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 91, §10, is amended to read:

**4. Identity.** The identity in the most descriptive terms commercially practicable, including any quality representation made in connection with the sale; and

**Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §2624**, as amended by PL 2001, c. 491, §2, is further amended by enacting at the end a new paragraph to read:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a vendor using a bulk sale delivery system equipped with the capability of issuing an electronic receipt, ticket or other recorded representation for a bulk sale may give a purchaser the option to receive any information required under this section through electronic means, such as a cellular telephone, a computer or e-mail, in lieu of or in addition to a paper delivery ticket. If the purchaser opts to receive information electronically, the vendor shall obtain the purchaser's consent in writing, which may be through electronic means.
