21 22 23 24 25 26	This amendment requires the Public Utilities Commission at least once every 5 years to audit report card data reported by a utility. It also eliminates the cap of \$1,000,000 on the administrative penalty that must be assessed on a utility that fails for 2 consecutive calendar quarters or otherwise consistently fails to meet a standard established by the commission pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 301, subsection 1-A, paragraph A.
