An Act To Fund and Support the Veterans Homes in Caribou and Machias and Require Legislative Approval for the Establishment and Closure of Veterans Homes

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

### Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §606-A is enacted to read:

# §606-A. Establishment or closure of Maine Veterans' Homes facility

If the Board of Trustees of the Maine Veterans' Homes proposes the establishment or closure of a facility managed by the board, the board shall submit its proposal and suggested legislation implementing the proposal to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over matters related to veterans, which may report out a bill based on the proposal. The board may not establish or close a facility managed by the board without specific legislative approval.

# Sec. 2. Department of Health and Human Services to amend rules; Maine Veterans' Homes. The Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules to allocate an emergency payment of \$75,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 and fiscal year 2022-23 to the Maine Veterans' Homes facilities located in Caribou and Machias. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

14 SUMMARY

The bill requires the Board of Trustees of the Maine Veterans' Homes to obtain legislative approval for the establishment or closure of a facility managed by the board. The bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to amend its rules to allocate emergency payments made in fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 to the veterans homes located in Caribou and Machias. The bill provides for one-time appropriations and allocations for the emergency payments.
