COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 732, L.D. 1904, Bill, “An Act To Prohibit the Practice of Female Genital Mutilation of a Minor”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §214 by striking out all of subsections 3 and 4 (page 1, lines 20 to 27 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 1 in §214 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is a minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety, removes the portions of the bill that make it a Class A crime to knowingly transport a female individual under 18 years of age outside of this State for purposes of female genital mutilation or to knowingly consent to female genital mutilation of a female individual under 18 years of age.
