## **An Act To Strengthen the Board of the Maine Insurance Guaranty Association**

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4437, first** ¶, as amended by PL 1985, c. 279, §3, is further amended to read:

The board of directors of the association shall <u>must</u> consist of not less than 7 persons serving terms as established in the plan of operation, and not less than 3 of the persons must represent members of the association that are domiciled in the State. The members of the board shall <u>must</u> be selected by member insurers subject to the approval of the superintendent. A member insurer serving on the board must resign if the member insurer ceases writing new insurance business in the State. Vacancies on the board shall <u>must</u> be filled for the remaining period of the term by a majority vote of the remaining board members, subject to the approval of the superintendent.
