An Act To Allow Municipalities and Counties To Require Bartender Training for Liquor Licensees

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

 - E. A violation of any provision of this Title; and
 - **Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §653, sub-§2, ¶F,** as enacted by PL 1989, c. 592, §4, is amended to read:
 - F. A determination by the municipal officers or county commissioners that the purpose of the application is to circumvent the provisions of section 601: ; and
 - Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §653, sub-§2, ¶G is enacted to read:
 - G. After September 1, 2010, server training, in a program certified by the bureau and required by local ordinance, has not been completed by individuals who serve alcoholic beverages.
