

§1055. Publication or distribution of political public communications

A political action committee that makes an expenditure to finance a public communication expressly advocating the election or defeat of a candidate or that names or depicts a clearly identified candidate is subject to the requirements of section 1014. [PL 2025, c. 224, §20 (AMD).]
