## §42-D. Poster of veterans' benefits and services

**1. Poster.** The bureau shall consult with the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services to create and distribute a veterans' benefits and services poster.

**2. Details.** The poster under this section must include, at a minimum, information regarding the following:

A. Contact and website information for the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services and services for veterans provided by that bureau; [PL 2023, c. 125, §1 (NEW).]

B. Substance use and mental health treatment services; [PL 2023, c. 125, §1 (NEW).]

C. Educational, workforce and training resources; [PL 2023, c. 125, §1 (NEW).]

E. Obtaining driver's licenses and nondriver identification cards; [PL 2023, c. 125, §1 (NEW).]
