Amend the amendment by striking out all of the mandate preamble (page 1, lines 17 to 21 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "submit the 2 plans under section 1" and inserting in its place the following: 'vote on which plan of the 2 under section 1 to send to the voters and may submit the plan'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by striking out the following: "receiving the higher number of votes"

SUMMARY

This amendment incorporates the substance of Senate Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A", filing number S-639. In addition, this amendment removes the requirement that the apportionment plan be submitted to the voters of Cumberland County and instead allows the plan to be submitted to the voters. This amendment also strikes the mandate preamble.
