Amend the amendment in paragraph P in the first line (page 1, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "<u>Records containing or describing security</u>" and inserting the following: '<u>Security</u>'

Amend the amendment in paragraph P in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "prepared" the following: 'for emergency events that are prepared'

Amend the amendment in paragraph P in the 7th line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "the Legislature," and inserting the following: 'state and'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the security plans, staffing plans, security procedures and other plans prepared for emergency events are not public records, but that the existence of such plans remains a public record. It also expands the list of individuals to whom that information can be disclosed to encompass Legislators and judges.
