An Act To Require Residents of the Unorganized Territories To Pay Excise Taxes To Agents and Not Directly to the Secretary of State

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1487, sub-§2-A, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 671, §34, is repealed.

SUMMARY

This bill repeals the provision of law that allows the State Tax Assessor to appoint the Secretary of State as an agent for the purpose of collecting excise tax for the unorganized territories.
