**An Act To Allow Members of the Armed Forces Who  
Are Not Residents but Own Property in this State To  
Obtain Resident Hunting and Fishing Licenses or Permits**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10752, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

**7. Nonresident member of United States Armed Forces.** A member of the Armed Forces of the United States who is not a resident of the State but who owns property in the State is eligible for a resident fishing, hunting or combination fishing and hunting license or permit.

**SUMMARY**

This bill allows a member of the United States Armed Forces who is not a resident of the State but who owns property in the State to purchase a resident fishing, hunting or combination fishing and hunting license or permit.
