Amend the bill in the 6th paragraph after the title in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "long-term care providers" and inserting the following: 'nursing facilities'

Amend the bill in the 6th paragraph after the title in the 2nd line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "to an amount that will" and inserting the following: 'in order to'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-I, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 498 and amended by PL 2003, c. 689, Pt. B, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- **3. Rules.** The department shall adopt rules to implement this section. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the rules must require reimbursement of nursing facilities for services rendered to a resident between the date an assessment under this section is due and the date the assessment is complete if:
 - A. The resident is assessed as medically eligible when the assessment occurs; and
 - B. The nursing facility has failed to request assessment no more than 2 times in a 12-month period.

SUMMARY
