## An Act To Strengthen Protection from Abuse and Protection from Harassment Laws

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

#### Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4655, sub-§6, ¶A is enacted to read:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, service of an order may be made pursuant to this section through the use of printed electronically transmitted copies of orders.

#### Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §4655, sub-§6, ¶B is enacted to read:

**B**. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an electronically transmitted report made by a person serving an order pursuant to this section constitutes proof that the order was served.

#### Sec. 3. 19-A MRSA §4006, sub-§6, ¶A is enacted to read:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, service of an order may be made pursuant to this section through the use of printed electronically transmitted copies of orders.

#### Sec. 4. 19-A MRSA §4006, sub-§6, ¶B is enacted to read:

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an electronically transmitted report made by a person serving an order pursuant to this section constitutes proof that the order was served.

# SUMMARY

This bill allows printed copies of electronically transmitted protection from harassment and protection from abuse orders to be served on individuals and allows a formal report of the service of such an order to be transmitted electronically.
