Amend the amendment in section 1 in §6005 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "System." and inserting the following: 'System only if additional federal funding is received to expand the department's kindergarten to grade 12 longitudinal data system existing as of the effective date of this section to a statewide system.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the Commissioner of Education may not require school administrative units to collect and report individual student social security numbers unless additional federal funding is received to expand the department's current kindergarten to grade 12 longitudinal data system to a statewide system.
