SUMMARY

14 This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, replaces the
15 appropriations and allocations section. Instead of providing a rate increase to all rates
16 under the Department of Health and Human Services rule Chapter 101: MaineCare
17 Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 65, Behavioral Health Services, the amendment
18 provides that the rate increase applies only to children's home and community-based
19 treatment services under that section.
