SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 136, L.D. 368, Bill, “An Act To Integrate the State's General Assistance and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Programs”

Amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 15 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "eligible" the following: 'and except that a person who has been ineligible to receive benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program for 5 or more years may be considered eligible'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds language to clarify that the provisions in the bill do not apply to a person who has been ineligible to receive benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program for 5 or more years.
