COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 350, L.D. 1010, Bill, “An Act To Afford Public Employers Flexibility To Achieve Efficiency and Quality in Management”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in the 5th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "perform" the following: 'noninstructional'

SUMMARY

The bill provides that the use of private contractors by a public employer to perform services for the public employer is not subject to negotiation in collective bargaining. This amendment, which is the minority report for the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development, specifies that the provision of the bill applies only to the use of contractors for noninstructional services.
