An Act To Clarify the Exemption of Federal, State and Local Public Assistance Benefits under State Bankruptcy Law

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §4422, sub-§13, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 431, §2, is amended to read:

A. A social security benefit, unemployment compensation or a <u>federal</u>, <u>state or</u> local public assistance benefit, <u>including</u>, <u>but not limited to</u>, the federal earned income tax credit and additional child tax credit;
